The situation in Afghanistan has been devastating. Thousands of individuals have been displaced or are currently stuck in Afghanistan with no clear picture on what their future holds.

The government of Canada has been actively working to assist Afghan refugees and is committed to increasing the number of eligible refugees to 40,000. This is being done through 2 programs:

- A special immigration program for Afghan nationals, and their families, who assisted the Government of Canada
- A special humanitarian program focused on resettling Afghan nationals

For each of these programs, there are specific eligibility

requirements that must be met.

Canada is also prioritizing applications for Afghan nationals, including family sponsorship applications, permanent residence applications, and temporary residence applications.

How Canadians Can Help

There are various ways in which Canadians can assist in efforts



to resettle Afghan nationals. This includes volunteering and donating, working with a resettlement program or service provider organization, and sponsoring an Afghan refugee. Below are some resources that you can check out to see how you can help.
